This range is not to be used as a training/testing facility. Members are allocated a period of 20mins in which to zero their firearm.</li> <li>3. Permission to run a barrel in is to be approved by the Range Office and subject to availability. Charges will still apply</li> <li>4. Purchase for use of the zero range is for on the day only</li> </ol>
