RUNNING BOAR RANGE**

THE RANGE	
Name	Running Boar (BSR Complex)
Description	Type: Constructed Full Danger Area Range Danger area: WDA 9mm pistol QE <220 Mil / 9mm carbine / .22RF rifle Location (What3words): Gosh.Owners.Deputy Distance: 25y to 50m Targets: 1x Moving target at 50 metres (.22" rifle only) - Up to 8 x Static Targets 25-50 yards (by prior arrangement) Additional notes: There is open access to other ranges within the BSR complex (see coordinating instructions below)
FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION	
Permitted firearms and ammunition including ME & MV	Type: .22" Target rifles and moving target rifles. Gallery rifles and pistols. Airguns are permitted. Maximum Muzzle Velocity: 655 m/s (2150 ft/s) Maximum Muzzle Energy: 2030 J (1496 ft lb) Special Requirements: - Rook Rifle and Gallery Rifle calibres within limits stated above are permitted for historic matches only or by prior arrangement with BSR Manager Not Permitted: .22 Hornet .22 Mag .17 of any type .300 Blackout .300 Whisper - Hollow point ammunition - Muzzle Loading/Black Powder firearms are not to be discharged on any electronic scoring targets
RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	- Shooting on this range affects the following ranges: - BSR - Statics - Running Deer 50yd Zeroing Range - Melville - Stickledown - Pirbright Access: - All movement forward of the Running Boar firing point requires the following ranges to have ceased fire, and must be coordinated by the BSR manager or delegate:

	i. Running Boar ii. 50yd Zeroing Range iii. Statics iv. Running Deer b. When there are personnel forward of the firing points, the red flag system is to be followed under the direction of the BSR Manager or delegate 3. A maximum of two shots are permitted per run of the moving target a. Another shooter may dry fire from the alternate lane 4. Vehicles are not permitted on the range floor without prior permission from the BSR manager
Firing positions	5. Moving target firing is to be conducted from the range hut. Static firing is to be conducted in lane from marked firing points at a minimum distance of 25 yards. 6. Positions permitted: a. Benched b. Standing
Targetry	7. MAX TCH: 1.5m 8. Targets from the BSR approved set and targets authorised for specific events by CE NSC may be used 9. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and/or appropriate shooting station or peg. 10. Moving Target is to be engaged from 50m. 11. Falling Plates or other hard targets may not be engaged within Running Boar Range
