Permitted firearms and ammunition including ME & MV	Type: Rifles Maximum Muzzle Velocity: 1000 m/s (3280 ft/s) Maximum Muzzle Energy: 7000 J (5160 ft lb) Note: - Gallery Rifles / Pistol calibres may be zeroed on this range when the member has a following booking on Century or Short Siberia Range
RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	- Shooting on this range has no effect on any other ranges. - This range is not to be used as a training/testing facility. Members are allocated a period of 20mins in which to zero their firearm. - Permission to run a barrel in is to be approved by the Range Office and subject to availability. Charges will still apply - Purchase for use of the zero range is for on the day only
Firing Positions	Positions Permitted (71.7ft only): - Prone - Supine - Benched
Targetry	MAX TCH: 1.5m - Frangible targets only. Self-provided paper or card target faces are permitted
